

Information on Visiting Wycombe Abbey School to see Witness for the Prosecution.

Wycombe Abbey are building a new front entrance to the school, and the building work means that the old entrance is currently unavailable.

Please follow the instructions below, and allow an extra 10 minutes if travelling by car. Pedestrians have to use an alternative entrance, but it will only add around 2 minutes.

Pedestrian Access

- The entrance is on the left as you go up Marlow Hill, just after the zebra crossing.
- Please press the intercom buzzer for entry and the site custodians will remotely release the gate.
- Follow the signs and make your way to the theatre. Walk behind the theatre to the next building which is the new Recital Hall.

Vehicle Access

- You will need to drive up Marlow Hill and turn left at the traffic lights into Daws Hill Lane. After 250m turn left into Crispin Lane.
- At the school gate please press the intercom buzzer for entry and the site custodians will remotely release the gate.
- After 200m there is a second gate, and if it is closed please use the intercom to gain entry.
- Follow the signs down the hill to the parking in Lime Avenue. Please note that there is a 10mph speed limit.
